Who Should Attend?

- * The program is aimed at youth who are completing grades 6, 7, and 8 in school. However, with proper preparation and expectations, 5th graders and older youth may find the program helpful and interesting, especially if they are part of a multi-age confirmation class.
- * Youth who have completed confirmation education, as well as those currently involved, are invited to attend.
- * **Pastors** and/or adults who have responsibility for confirmation education or may be serving as mentors for confirmands at the local church.

(Groups will need at least one chaperone of the same gender as the youth attending.

Co-ed groups will require at least two adults - one male and one female. We recommend a ratio of one adult to every 6 youth.)

Registration: Cost for supper on Friday, breakfast and lunch on Saturday, snacks, and lodging will be \$52.00 for each participant. You can save \$4 per person by getting completed registration forms and payment to Camp Overlook **BEFORE March 13th**. 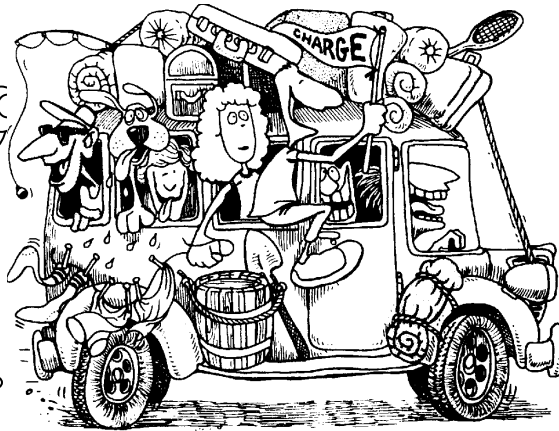
