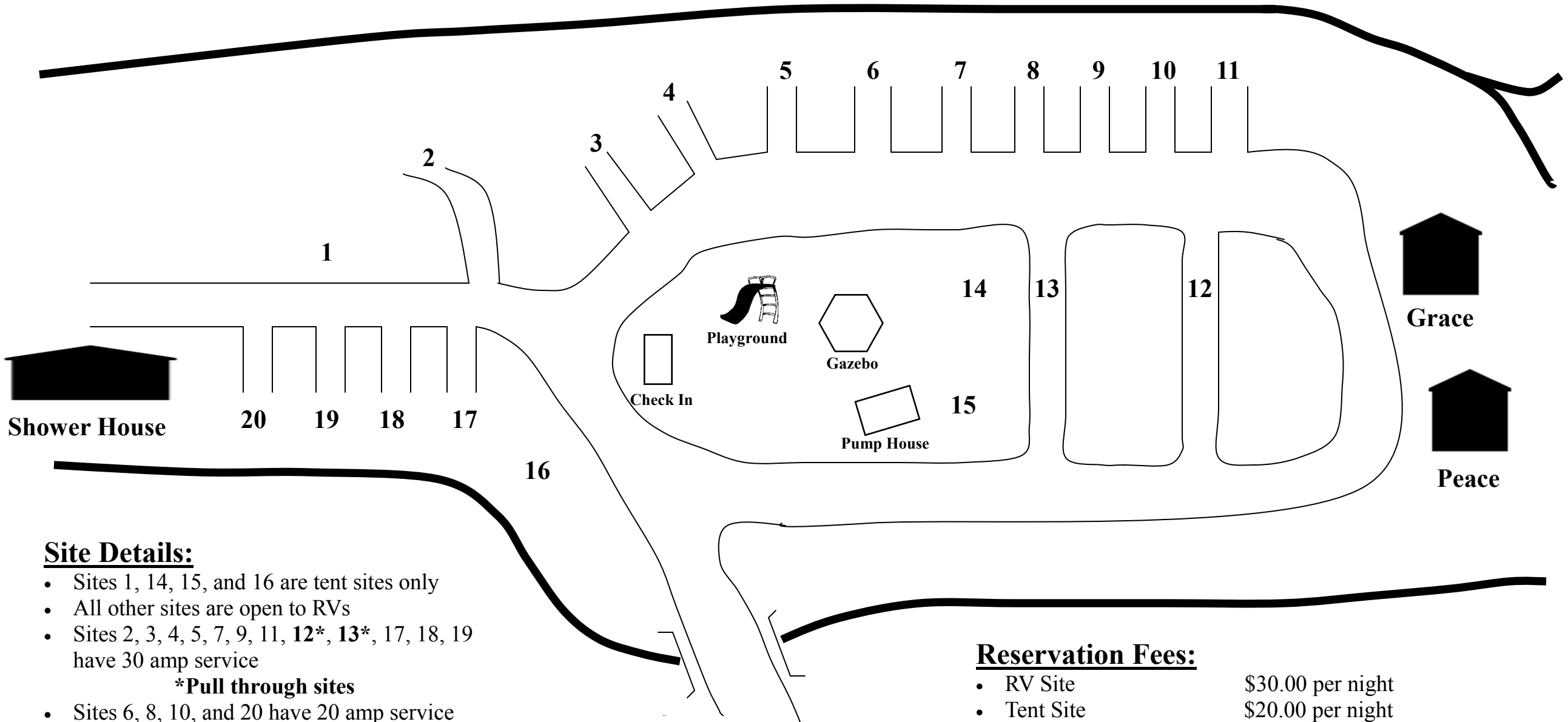


# Camp Overlook Family Campground



## Site Details:

- Sites 1, 14, 15, and 16 are tent sites only
- All other sites are open to RVs
- Sites 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 9, 11, 12\*, 13\*, 17, 18, 19 have 30 amp service
  - \*Pull through sites
- Sites 6, 8, 10, and 20 have 20 amp service
- Water and electric are available in every site
- Dump station available outside shower house
- **GRACE** and **PEACE** are small, one room cabins with bunk bed sleeping for 6.

## Reservation Fees:

- RV Site \$30.00 per night
- Tent Site \$20.00 per night
- One Pioneer Building \$45.00 per night
- Scouts/Youth Group \$5.00 per person/per night
- *The Overlook Camping Club* 10 passes for \$200.00

## Stay Safe and Keep Our Campground Looking Nice

-Youth and children must be supervised by an adult at all times.

-Respect the privacy of other families and groups. This is especially critical around retreat buildings of other groups in camp.

-Recognize health and safety hazards. SMOKING, DRINKING, and SUBSTANCES OF ABUSE are prohibited.

-Drive slowly and keep all vehicles on the roads. Speed limit is 10 mph.

-You must clean up after pets and they should remain on a leash at all times. Campers with animals that are excessively noisy or become aggressive may be asked to leave.

-Campfire wood may be obtained from existing piles in central locations. Check with the management before cutting anything other than fallen limbs.

-Campfires should be out/cold before checking out.

-Campground will be closed to guests during the summer weekdays.

-Water is turned off to the campground and the shower house is locked from late fall through early spring.

*Resting at the foot of the Massanutten Mountains, bordered by the national forest and gurgling streams, the Family Campground is the respite your family needs.*

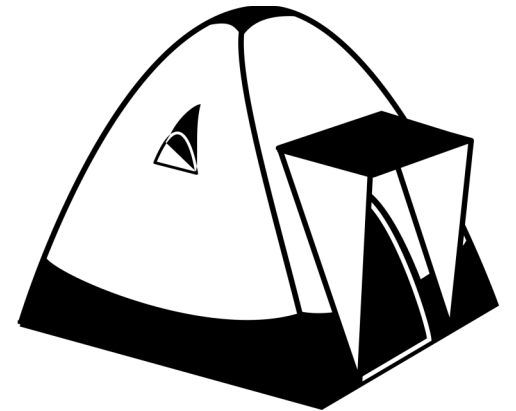
